The final round was here and 9 drivers braved the cold damp conditions of the night. The Championship had already been decided so the drivers were under no pressure from this last round - thankfully!

With the unique way the weight categories are divided and the majority of the drivers were "Cuddly", it would see a change for the leading driver Steve Hall to be the heaviest light. The control weight this month being 95kg!

A good qualifying session with the quickest time in the damp of 1.06.768 by (S) Norman Kenvyn who took pole, (S) Dave Austen 2nd, (L) Steve Hall 3rd, (L) Peter Sharp 4th, (S) Lee Probert 5th, (S) Bill Jennings 6th, (L) Dan Parker 7th, (L) Guy Imray 8th and Adam Kuzimski 9th.

Heat 1 and they all waited patiently for the green lights. With the conditions more favourable to the "heavier" 7 drivers. There was plenty of tarmac for them all. Very quickly Norman lost the lead and Dave was ahead with Steve not very far behind. For the first 10 minutes of the race only the top three changed places. Leaving Peter, Lee, Bill, Dan, Guy and Adam to follow behind.

After 20 minutes, Steve Hall crossed the line 3 seconds ahead of Dave Austen 2nd, followed by Norman Kenvyn 3rd, Peter Sharp 4th, Lee Probert 5th, Bill Jennings 6th, Dan Parker 7th, Guy Imray 8th and Adam Kuzimski 9th.

Heat 2 and the Reverse Grid. A good start and "Stormin Norman" very quickly made his way to the front with Peter Sharp trying to stay with him. Dave Austen worked his way into 3rd half way through the lap with the rest of the grid steady behind.

Another heat over and Norman Kenvyn "just" took the win 0.14 seconds in front of Dave Austen 2nd, Lee Probert 3rd, Peter Sharp 4th, Bill Jennings 5th, Steve Hall 6th, Dan Parker 7th, Guy Imray 8th, and Adam Kuzimski 9th. 13th.

Adding the points for the final heat and there is a 4 way tie for pole. Going to the fastest laps put Steve Hall on pole, Dave Austen 2nd, Norman Kenvyn 3rd and Peter Sharp 4th. The next 3 drivers all had the same points, and on lap times, Lee Probert 5th, Bill Jennings 6th, Dan Parker 7th, followed by Guy Imray 8th and Adam Kuzimski 9th.

The clock had finally ticked down and the chequered flag. A comfortable win for Dave Austen, Lee Probert came round Café in 2nd, but after the previous incident courtesy slowed to let Norman Kenyvyn take 2nd, Lee Probert 3rd, Steve Hall 4th, Peter Sharp 5th, Bill Jennings 6th, Dan Parker 7th, Guy Imray 8th and Adam Kuzimski 9th.

Steve Hall is Crowned 320 Challenge 2007 Champion with 705 points, Norman Kenyvyn Runner Up with 693 points and Haydn Brown 3rd with 675 points. Congratulations to the winners and all those who have taken part in this event in 2007.
