Shake n Bake who had won the Championship forever ago were absent tonight (Excuse by Paul was "He had to pay for his pussy" wait for it ..... "when it went to the vets!!").

After signing on, warm mince-pies and an unexpected visit from Santa the drivers went for their driver briefing. Usual Race Director Phil Ling had booked the day off as he had the Buckmore Do the night before!!, but made of stronger stuff and out of retirement for the night, we welcomed Chris Pullman.

At first sight we thought it had been snowing, but the white track was as the air temperature dropped. This is great value for money, karting and skating all in one!!

With a time of 1.10.985 Santa "Nip & Tuck" took pole, following by Fat & Furious 2<sup>nd</sup>, Team 2007 3<sup>rd</sup>, Turn & Burn 4<sup>th</sup>, KP Nuts 5<sup>th</sup>, Spin Doctors 6<sup>th</sup>, BAR Honda 7<sup>th</sup>, GPL 8<sup>th</sup>, Dogz 9<sup>th</sup>, Spongebob Squarepants 10<sup>th</sup>, The Old Gits 11<sup>th</sup>, Lift Away 12<sup>th</sup>, Anthill Mob 13<sup>th</sup>, Grand Pre 14<sup>th</sup>, Steptoe & Son 15<sup>th</sup>, Space Cadets 16<sup>th</sup>, Superchip 17<sup>th</sup>, 49ers 18<sup>th</sup>, Speed Boys 19<sup>th</sup>, Still Game 20<sup>th</sup>, City Odds 21<sup>st</sup>.

As the lights went to green the bright Red Santa (Nip & Tuck) made his way round with the pack behind, a few spinners at hairpin 2 where there was little or maybe NO grip at all. As they completed the first lap Nip & Tuck held 1<sup>st</sup>, KP Nuts into 2<sup>nd</sup>, Turn & Burn 3<sup>rd</sup>, Fat & Furious 4<sup>th</sup> and The Old Gits 5<sup>th</sup>. The three teams who were battling for 3<sup>rd</sup> in the Championship were further down the grid, just inside the top 10.

As the race continued the racing line was more apparent, well to most. Speed Boys spent most of the race doing 360 degree turn, I should think he was dizzy by the end of his stint!

Lap 14 and 3 karts, KP Nuts, Fat & Furious and Turn & Burn, three abreast into the esses, in these or any other conditions, they were not going to ALL make it! Turn & Burn held their nerve, keeping KP Nuts behind with Fat & Furious close by.

As the Union flag went out for the 10 minute window for the driver changes, the first three teams were on the same lap, then the next 8. This would all change during the pit stops. Time was getting on and steadily they “slipped” into the pits. As we watched the teams in and out of the pits, Dogz arrived but his driver was not ready, this would cost them valuable time and would not help with their championship points. This was not the only team not to be ready or change in time. The most experienced (in age) of the Steptoe and Son team was outside the change over time, so was black flagged.

At 40 minutes Nip & Tuck were 35 seconds in the lead from Team 2007 in 2<sup>nd</sup>, Fat & Furious 3<sup>rd</sup>, KP Nuts 4<sup>th</sup>, Turn & Burn 5<sup>th</sup>, Dogz 6<sup>th</sup>, BAR Honda 7<sup>th</sup>, The Old Gits 8<sup>th</sup>, Lift Away 9<sup>th</sup>, Steptoe & Son 10<sup>th</sup>, GPL 11<sup>th</sup>, Superchip 12<sup>th</sup>, Spin Doctors 13<sup>th</sup>, Grand Pre 14<sup>th</sup>, Spongebob Squarepants 15<sup>th</sup>, Space Cadets 16<sup>th</sup>, Anthill Mob 17<sup>th</sup>, Still Game 18<sup>th</sup>, 49ers 19<sup>th</sup>, City Odds 20<sup>th</sup> and Speed Boys 21<sup>st</sup>.

We were now counting down the time to end the Enduro Series 2007 and see who would claim the 3<sup>rd</sup> Championship position. Team 2007 were still holding onto 2<sup>nd</sup>, BAR Honda 6<sup>th</sup> and Dogz 7<sup>th</sup>. Further down the grid two new drivers in both 49ers and Speed Boys 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> had been black flagged due to getting out of the kart, which is a NO, NO.

For the final time this year the chequered flag fell with Santa’s little helper (Nip & Tuck) crossing the line 45 seconds ahead of Team 2007, 3<sup>rd</sup> KP Nuts, Fat & Furious 4<sup>th</sup>, BAR Honda 5<sup>th</sup>, Turn & Burn 6<sup>th</sup>, Lift Away 7<sup>th</sup>, Dogz 8<sup>th</sup>, Steptoe & Son 9<sup>th</sup>, The Old Gits 10<sup>th</sup>, Superchip 11<sup>th</sup>, GPL 12<sup>th</sup>, Grand Pre 13<sup>th</sup>, Spin Doctors 14<sup>th</sup>, Spongebob Squarepants 15<sup>th</sup>, Space Cadets 16<sup>th</sup>, Anthill Mob 17<sup>th</sup>, Still Game 18<sup>th</sup>, 49ers 19<sup>th</sup>, Speed Boys 20<sup>th</sup> and City Odds 21<sup>st</sup>.

After the event a buffet and drinks were provided to the drivers and whilst they tucked in we calculated the Championship points. First, we did the nights presentation which dragged out the inevitable for two of the teams for a little longer.

As we know, Shake n Bake are the Enduro Series 2007 Winners, Nip & Tuck 2<sup>nd</sup> and .....after a great driver by both drivers a well deserved 3<sup>rd</sup> goes to Team 2007.

With the conditions as they were a great night was had by all, exceptional driving under the circumstances of the weather. Described by some of the drivers as “Great Fun!”

Congratulations to all everyone who has enjoyed the 12<sup>th</sup> year of the Enduro Series. The 13<sup>th</sup> year of this event will see two classes per round. Thunderkarts and Pros.
