# **ENDURO SERIES 2009**

**ONE HOUR TEAM ENDURANCE CHAMPIONSHIP**

**DATE 15.07.09 > TRACK BUCKMORE PARK > TRACK CONDITION DRY > TEAMS 22**  
**FASTEST LAPS S & M RACING – 50.036**

July and half-way through the season already for round 5.

At driver briefing we first congratulated "Equipe Vitesse" for their great win at the 24 hour Le Mans – Well done to Joe Flay, Russell Crowe and Simon Rudd, after 24 hours, 2 punctures, one mistaken drive through penalty and a few other technical problems they won by 1 lap. Congratulations too went to the other teams and drivers Buckmore Thunder, Buckmore Lightening, Blue Lizard (Geoff Lamb – KP Nuts) and ACS.

Qualifying saw a mix of times and positions for the regular teams as some of the drivers felt that their kart was "off the pace" whatever that means so changed. So many things can make the karts seem quicker or slower every month. Track temperature, air temperature, track conditions and let's not forget "driver ability" although I'm sure the old saying goes "A Bad workman, always blames his TOOLS!!".

Only 6 teams made it into the 50s and Lift Away were the first of those on pole with a time of 50.524, S & M Racing 2<sup>nd</sup>, Dodgy Gits 3<sup>rd</sup>, KP Nuts 4<sup>th</sup>, GPL 5<sup>th</sup>, Grand Pre 6<sup>th</sup>, Team 2009 7<sup>th</sup>, Team Christie 8<sup>th</sup>, Bee Gees 9<sup>th</sup>, Dad & Lad 10<sup>th</sup>, Steptoe & Son 11<sup>th</sup>, Nip & Tuck 12<sup>th</sup>, 49ers 13<sup>th</sup>, The Anthill Mob 14<sup>th</sup>, The McUshers 15<sup>th</sup>, The Stalkers 16<sup>th</sup>, Primo Racing 17<sup>th</sup>, McRacing 18<sup>th</sup>, Mongo 19<sup>th</sup>, 21<sup>st</sup> Century 20<sup>th</sup>, Anonmous 21<sup>st</sup> and Sargeant 22<sup>nd</sup>.

Green lights start the race and Lift Away shoot off into the distance with Dodgy Gits close behind. Nip & Tuck who unusually started 12<sup>th</sup> after a couple of kart changes made a great start too.

A battle ensuing between Steptoe & Son and McRacing who were wheel to wheel at conways, Steptoe & Son losing out as they come into hairpin one.

Lift Away had the advantage of the stand-in driver Matt (multi-talented Rudd (he told me to put that!) who was pulling away from Matt (Jones) of S & M Racing. Further down the grid in 17<sup>th</sup> wherever that is for Primo Racing they were working their way back up the field.

As we approach the half way point for driver changes the positions are Lift Away 1<sup>st</sup>, S & M Racing 2<sup>nd</sup>, GPL 3<sup>rd</sup>, Nip & Tuck 4<sup>th</sup>, KP Nuts 5<sup>th</sup>, Dodgy Gits 6<sup>th</sup>, Grand Pre 7<sup>th</sup>, Team 2009 8<sup>th</sup>, Bee Gees 9<sup>th</sup>, Team Christie 10<sup>th</sup>, The Anthill Mob 11<sup>th</sup>, The McUshers 12<sup>th</sup>, The Stalkers 13<sup>th</sup>, Dad & Lad 14<sup>th</sup>, McRacing 15<sup>th</sup>, Mongo 16<sup>th</sup>, Steptoe & Son 17<sup>th</sup>, Primo Racing 18<sup>th</sup>, 49ers 19<sup>th</sup>, 21<sup>st</sup> Century 20<sup>th</sup>, Anonmous 21<sup>st</sup> and Sargeant 22<sup>nd</sup>.

Driver changes are between 25 – 35 minutes into the race and GPL are the first into the pits for their driver change.

As we settle into the 2<sup>nd</sup> half of the race, we see Lift Away now "Just" in the lead with S & M Racing a very close second. Very cosy were Nip & Tuck, Dodgy Gits and Team 2009 with Grand Pre just keeping an eye on when the door would open and a mistake that they could take a place or two!
