## Revolver Racing are gunning for top spot!

Round 2 of the Enduroseries and a dry but cold evening.

Qualifying went well with over half the grid in the 50s. Revolver Racing took pole with a time of 50.228 and only just behind Lift Away 2<sup>nd</sup>, Datech 3<sup>rd</sup>, AIS 4<sup>th</sup>, Team Pheonix 2010 5<sup>th</sup>, A Right Pair 6<sup>th</sup>, Alimatt 7<sup>th</sup>, KP Nuts 8<sup>th</sup>, Lost the Plot 9<sup>th</sup>, Grand Pre 10<sup>th</sup>, GPL 11<sup>th</sup>, Luke & Tuck 12<sup>th</sup>, Barry Racing 13<sup>th</sup>, Rogue Traders 14<sup>th</sup>, Still Game 15<sup>th</sup> and Davelution 16<sup>th</sup>.

As the lights change we see Lift Away with a great start into the lead, controlling the pack followed closely by Team Pheonix 2010, AIS and Datech. The early losers of the first lap are pole sitters Revolver Racing but they were on a mission.

As the grid settles Lift Away still dominate the pack with an incident for Team Pheonix 2010 relegating them 13<sup>th</sup> and allowing Lost the Plot and Revolver Racing to move back up to the front of the grid.

Obviously enjoying being out in the lead, the weather and scenery, Lift Away must have lost concentration for a millisecond as on lap 13 the kart is seen spinning at Conways with no other kart in sight. Unfortunatley, other karts did appear and the lead was taken by Datech.

Barry Racing decides to make a pit-stop and change their kart as they feel it is "off the pace" but now places them in last position.

As we near the halfway point, Revolver Racing takes the lead, Lost the Plot 2<sup>nd</sup>, Datech 3<sup>rd</sup>, Team Pheonix 2010 4<sup>th</sup>, Lift Away 5<sup>th</sup>, KP Nuts 6<sup>th</sup>, Alimatt 7<sup>th</sup>, Luke & Tuck 8<sup>th</sup>, GPL 9<sup>th</sup>, A Right Pair 10<sup>th</sup>, Grand Pre 11<sup>th</sup>, AIS 12<sup>th</sup>, Rogue Traders 13<sup>th</sup>, Still Game 14<sup>th</sup>, Davelution 15<sup>th</sup> and Barry Racing 16<sup>th</sup>.

The 10 minute window opens for driver changes and Luke & Tuck are the first team to pit with Team Pheonix 2010 the last team to change with just under a minute to spare.

Back to the race and the second drivers and a great battle was ensuing between Lift Away and Datech. Both experienced drivers was swapping places lap after lap enjoying a great race. Also AIS and A Right Pair were trading places both trying for the same piece of tarmac.

Alimatt (Alice Goad) takes the fastest lap of 49.629 whilst battling to take 5<sup>th</sup> position. Barry Racing who changed kart may have made the wrong decision as their replacement was on a go slow!

At the front of the grid the battle was still on for a position for Lift Away 3<sup>rd</sup> and Datech 4<sup>th</sup>. Lap after lap they were exchanging the black stuff until a over zealous move by Datech across the grass at hairpin 2 crosses the path of Lift Away which then sees Lift Away then taking a tight line into the esses with Datech very close and personal to the barrier!
