Luke & Tuck Gain Full Marks

The first of the Warm evenings for round 3 of the Enduroseries and 20 teams sign in. We welcome two teams who have progressed from our Fun Race - father and son Max snr & Max Smith jnr in Who's the Daddy and Andy & John Butcher in That'll do both young men entering the event at 16 and weighing a few pounds more than birth - the sons that is!

Only two teams made the 49s for Qualifying Luke & Tuck took pole 49.436 and Lift Away 2nd 49.943. KP Nuts 3rd, Team Phoenix 2010 4th, Datech 5th, Billy No Mates 6th, AIS 7th, Team Alimatt 8th, GPL 9th, R & A Racing 10th, Grand Pre 11th, Cobra Racing 12th, Revolver Racing 13th, Little & Large 14th, Who's the Daddy 15th, Lost the Plot 16th, RD Racing 17th, Barry Racing 18th, Still Game 19th and That'll Do 20th.

Although qualifying 4th, Team Phoenix 2010 were one of the teams who changed their kart in practice. This they did on the last lap and felt that the kart was back to the phrase "off the pace" and they wanted the original one they rejected. The rules state unless mechanical problems, no karts will be changed on the grid and they could complete one lap and bring the kart in. To all intents and purposes, this is what they wanted to do!! Another team who felt they were plagued with gremlins were KP Nuts qualified 3rd, and they too changed karts but never got into their stride.

With lights to green, 2nd place Lift Away capapult off the line to take the lead, closely followed by Luke & Tuck and a great move by Alice Goad in Alimatt from 8th to 3rd and also R & A Racing move up from 10th to 6th. Unfortunately RD Racing and Billy No Mates lost places in the first lap.

As mentioned previously we eagerly awaited 4th on the grid Team Phoenix 2010 to come and change the kart they said after one lap in practice was "rubbish!". Mmmm..... now in 3rd with the "rubbish" kart they pass the pit lane entrance and over the line to start their next lap and next and next.....

The battle of the front was great. Luke & Tuck took the lead on lap 3 and Lift Away were with them all the way, not a gnats between them!

A spin sees AIS down to 19th whilst KP Nuts takes an advantage and passes Datech but only for a lap and the same with Grand Pre taking the lead over Cobra Racing.

KP Nuts seemed to be going backwards as next to pass them is Team Alimatt to take a place prompting them to come in and make a kart change relegating them to 14!

The battle at the front of the grid makes great racing with both teams taking their fastest lap with Lift Away taking the fastest lap of the race 49.480 on lap 12.

As we near the driver changes Luke & Tuck lead by 17s, Lift Away 2nd, Team Pheonix 2010 3rd, Datech 4th, Team Alimatt 5th, Revolver Racing 6th, R & A Racing 7th, Billy No Mates 8th, Grand Pre 9th, KP Nuts 10th, AIS 11th, Cobra Racing 12th, Lost the Plot 13th, Little & Large 14th, GPL 15th, Barry Racing 16th, Still Game 17th, Who's the Daddy 18th, RD Racing 19th and That'll Do 20th.

With a minute to go before the driver changes, two teams come in That'll Do and Lost the Plot, both then getting a drive through penalty.

As the 10 minute driver change window opens RD Racing are the first to pit and with Lift Away coming in with a minute to spare.

With all changes complete, Luke & Tuck still lead, Lift Away 2nd, Team Pheonix 2010 3rd, Datech 4th, Team Alimatt 5th, Revolver Racing 6th, R & Racing 7th, KP Nuts 8th, AIS 9th, Grand Pre 10th, Cobra Racing 11th, Billy No Mates 12th, GPL 13th, Lost the Plot 14th, Barry Racing 15th, Who's the Daddy 16th, Little & Large 17th, Still Game 18th, RD Racing 19th and That'll Do 20th.

A little "wobble" from That'll Do at the back sees them spin out but gain their composure and return back to the race. GPL meanwhile are called into the pits as their Airflow pipe is loose. A kart change and put back into position they continue with the race.

As yellows are deployed at post 5 we hear that Team Alimatt have pulled over as their throttle cable had gone, where who knows but this put them from a well deserved 6th down to 13th.

The teams were very evenly matched tonight with lots of battles but the top 5 places always seemed to have their points in the bag.

After one hour, Pole sitters and race leaders for 72 laps Luke & Tuck take the chequered by 16 seconds ahead of Lift Away 2nd and Team Phoenix 2010 3rd all on the same lap. Datech 5th, KP Nuts 5th, Grand Pre 6th, Revolver 7th, AIS 8th, R & A Racing 9th, GPL 10th, Cobra Racing 11th, Billy No Mates 12th, Team Alimatt 13th, Barry Racing 14th, Who's the Daddy 15th, Lost the Plot 16th, Little & Large 17th, RD Racing 18th, Still Game 19th and That'll Do 20th.

May I take this opportunity to say how well our two "juniors" from the Fun Races Max (Who's the Daddy) and John (That'll Do) did. Both young men did a sterling job for their teams – their dads weren't bad either!!
