Full marks for Luke & Tuck and top of the table !

Half way through the season already. Where does the time go?

The weather had been good to us again for the Enduro and with a slight breeze conditions were good.

At driver briefing a rendition of "Happy Birthday" from the drivers for Race Director Phil Ling whose birthday it will be on Friday.

Qualifying went well also Lift Away had a loose petrol cap and unfortunately this would not be the first of their problems or karts tonight!

Luke & Tuck took pole with a time of 50.689, KP Nuts 2nd, GPL 3rd, Revolver Racing 4th, Team Pheonix 2010 5th, Team Alimatt 6th, AIS 7th, Datech 8th, Grand Pre 9th, Barry Racing 10th, R & A Racing 11th, Screaming Tarts 12th, Still Game 13th, Lift Away 14th, Mario Karts 15th and Team Pez 16th.

All gridded and green for go. Luke & Tuck and GPL make the first bend together with Team Alimatt making a move on KP Nuts at the first hairpin.

After one lap Lift Away come in for their "first" kart change and filter onto the back of the pack and try to make up some ground but it looks like their kart doesn't want to play that game and within 8 laps they are in for their "Second" kart change.

Luke & Tuck are now starting to pull away and Revolver Racing are on their heels. KP Nuts & Alimatt having their own battle and getting quite close resulting in a contact for the talented but forceful Alice but she did not give up and kept the pressure on eventually taking 3rd – Go Girl!

A good move by Team Pez on Screaming Tarts moves them up a place and Mario Karts also gaining a place as for Lift Away come in for their "third" kart on lap 22.

As we reach the driver change window, Luke & Tuck are still in the lead, Revolver Racing 2nd, Team Alimatt 3rd, KP Nuts 4th, GPL 5th, Team Pheonix 2010 6th, AIS 7th, Barry Racing 8th, Grand Pre 9th, Screaming Tarts 10th, R & A Racing 11th, Datech 12th, Still Game 13th, Mario Karts 14th, Team Pez 15th and Lift Away 16th.

Team Pez are the first to change driver closely followed by Lift Away who were going to retire as they needed yet another kart but felt they had been through all the spares, but there were two they hadn't tried!! Race Director Phil Ling who as ever diplomatically suggested they go out and finish the race to gain some championship points and have some track time. Another change of kart and driver and off they went. The last change was Alimatt with 50 seconds to spare.

As the second drivers settle into the race, The Old Buck of Luke & Tuck has taken the mantle and is now nearly a lap ahead of the field. Revolver Racing 2nd, KP Nuts 3rd, GPL 4th, AIS 5th, Team Alimatt 6th, Team Pheonix 7th all a lap behind the leader. R & A Racing 8th, Barry Racing 9th, Datech 10th, Grand Pre 11th, Screaming Tarts 12th, Still Game 13th, Lift Away 14th, Mario Karts 15th and Team Pez 16th.

AIS were on a mission first passing Team Pheonix 2010 then, Team Alimatt and then looking for GPL to take 4th. Datech had a kart that was pretending to be in Pro mode and seemed to be going backwards. This kart wasn't powered by horses but retired ponies.

As three karts met at Conways together, KP Nuts on the inside, Lift Away in the middle and Screaming Tarts on the outside, only one would get through, one would get a contact and one would be close and personal with the tyre wall. KP Nuts were through, edging out Lift Away who had nowhere to go except, you guessed it, into Screaming Tarts.

Racing for positions GPL 4th and Revolving Racing 3rd are side by side into the Esses and down the hill but an over zealous move by GPL sees them picking up their third contact and the only Black Flag and losing out two places once they rejoined the track now into 5th as AIS took advantage.

With a battle between Team Alimatt and Team Pheonix 2010 ensuing, R & A Racing see an opportunity to make a move on both teams moving up two positions. Team Pheonix 2010 keep the pressure up and soon pass Team Alimatt moving back into 7th.

As the clock ticks down and the end is nigh, all teams seem to have settled into their final positions except GPL!

After one hour and 72 laps, Luke & Tuck who had lead the race from the off crossed the line to take a well deserved win. KP Nuts 2nd, Revolver Racing 3rd, GPL 4th, AIS 5th all a lap down. R & A Racing 6th, Team Pheonix 2010 7th, Team Alimatt 8th, Barry Racing 9th and Datech 10th all on 70 laps. Grand Pre 11th, Still Game 12th, Screaming Tarts 13th, Lift Away 14th but the only team to boast they have tried all the karts in the fleet - well nearly! Mario Karts 15th and Team Pez 16th.

A good nights racing with a lot of position changes especially in the first part of the race which re-arranges the championship table. Even though there were a few mechanical problems "off the Pace" all was taken in good part and all teams to the bar for a well deserved beverage.
