ONE HOUR TEAM ENDURANCE CHAMPIONSHIP

2010 Rules & Regulations

Enduro Series is a one hour team race format with 2 drivers in each team. The event is to promote a friendly, competitive, fair and enjoyable race series. All drivers must be 16 years old or over or 14 years old or over with a valid and current MSA licence (subject to race directors approval). Normal Buckmore Park general rules and regulations apply.

Format

There is a 10 minute practice/qualifying period and then 1 x 60 minute race where championship points will be awarded every 10 minutes (except 30 minutes due to pit stops). The team passing the chequered flag first are the winners on the night and the points accumulated during the race added to the championship score. At the end of the season the team accumulating the most championship points are the championship winners.

The Karts

The karts for this championship will be the Buckmore Park RX7 Pro karts prepared, maintained and owned by Buckmore Park.

Arrival & Sign on

Drivers will sign on and attend driver briefing. Any driver not attending driver briefing will not be able to take part. Teams are required to have completed signing on by 19.30hrs. Drivers arriving after this time will be deducted 10 points from the round total and drivers arriving after 19.45hrs will be deducted 20 points.

Qualifying

A 10 minute qualifying period to determine the class grid will take place. All drivers must take part in qualifying. Teams may change their karts if required during practice/qualifying until the chequered flag has been shown. Karts may not be changed after the qualifying/practice period chequered flag and before the race start, unless authorised by the Race Director due to mechanical or safety reasons.

The Grid

At the end of the 10 minute qualifying period, pole position in class gets 30 points, second 29 points third 28 points and so on down to 1 point in both classes. The grid will be formed with the fastest qualifying time in pole position and the slowest last.

The Race

Every 10 minutes during the one hour race, each team in class receives points based on their position, again 30 points for first, second 29 points third 28 points and so on down to 1 point. The exception is that no points are awarded in the race at the 30 minute stage, due to the compulsory driver change pit stops, which must take place between 25 & 35 minutes.

Round Result

The final race result will be the first past the chequered flag at race end.

Championship points

Points scored in the round will count towards the Enduro Series 2010 championship. 8 out of 10 rounds scored will be counted towards the championship. Double championship points will be awarded at round 10

Awards

Trophies will be provided for the top 3 drivers of each round. Championship trophies will be awarded to the top 3 teams accumulating the most points at the end of Round 10.

Race Director & Organiser

Buckmore Park Karting Limited general circuit rules apply. Full race safety briefing and details will be given at each race, BPKL & DJML have the right to exclude any driver without refund. The race director and organisers decision is final and these rules may change after consultation with the race director and competitors.
